**ACBL Coordinator Report (Club Manager Report)**

Sheila Dipple reported on the following:

- 1) STAC games will be on Tuesday, July 1st. and Wednesday, July 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- 2) NAP qualifying games occur once a month in June, July, and August.
- 3) Directors will continue to provide hand records, if they desire. The actual time to do the Promaster Program is 30 minutes.
- 4) Director fees have been informally discussed and tabled. Rick O'Conner and John Woeste will consult with the Board regarding fees.

**B. Duplimate Issues**

- 1. Courtney Thurman shared her thoughts on computer dealt hands. Many players object to hands dealt by computer.**
- 2. Rick O'Connor suggested giving the membership more information. Thus, a "Pro and Con List" will be compiled.**
- 3. Betty Hurst remarked that because the Wednesday games have too few players, the amount of work entailed in preparing computer hands would not be commensurate with the Director's fee, which in all likelihood would be only \$20.00-\$28.00.**
- 4. Dan Hance and Mary Zurborg suggested alternating computer dealt hands (with handouts), and that some games be "shuffle and deal hands."**
- 5. Jack Mehalko suggested the following:**
  - a. No hand records in June.**
  - b. He also suggested having a ballot for the membership to vote their choice in terms of these issues. The ballot would be presented to the membership in August.**
  - c. Jack also reported that members are requesting the Wednesday evening games be completed by 10:00p.m. It was suggested that we use a timer and call the round for faster play.**
  - d. Score sheet costs is \$42.00 for 3000 sheets. We use approximately 90 sheets per game.**
  - e. Parking is becoming difficult.**
  - f. Will we have a charity game? Sheila Dipple reported no.**
